

PHOTO MOUNTNG INSTRUCTIONS:

Photography entries must be mounted according to these rules.

- 1. Studio photo mount board must be used.
- 2. Studio photo mount board may be purchased at your local extension office or KSRE bookstore, Manhattan, Ks.
- 3. Use the Photo Display Instructions as a guide for correct photo and ID Form placement.
- 4. Photo mount size is 11" wide by 12 1/2" in length. (see below)
- 5. Photo mount is always orientated with 11" side as the top of mount.
- 6. Mount each photo 1" down from the top (both horizontal and vertical orientation) of the mount board and equal distance from each side.
- 7. Correct mounting adhesive must be used. Use only adhesives designed for permanent photography mounting. Do not use rubber cement, white glue, double stick tape or other household adhesives.
- 8. Fill out and attach I.D. Label on bottom 1" of photo mount.
- 9. Place mounted photo in clear photography bag. These may be purchased at your local extension office or the KSRE Bookstore, Manhattan, Ks.
- 10.DO NOT seal photography bag until judging is completed.
- 11. Photos improperly mounted will be lowered one ribbon placing.



COUNTY FAIR ID LABEL:

- 1. Fill out ID Label. Cut on dashed lines only, do not trim edges.
- 2. Attach to bottom edge of photo mount board with clear tape by folding tape around each edge onto back of mount.
- 3.DO NOT stick tape to front of mount board, only ID Label.
- 4. Print your Name, District name and county in the district. If you are not in a district, print county name only.
- 5. Use class numbers from your local fair book.
- 6. List number of years 4-H member has been enrolled in the photography project.
- 7. Check type of camera used then check FILM or DIGITAL.

STATE FAIR ID LABEL:

- 1. Once your local extension office enters your photo, the State 4-H Office will print a State Fair Photography Entry Label for each photo entered and mail to the extension office.
- 2. Place the State Fair Photography Entry Label (sticker) over the center section of the ID FORM
- 3. Make sure release form for special use is filled out, signed and placed behind the photo in the plastic bag.
- 4. Place photo in clear photography bag but do not seal.
- 5. Clear bag will be sealed once judging takes place.
