

Dear Johnson County 4-H Ambassador Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in applying for Johnson County 4-H Ambassadors for the 2024 4-H year. The Ambassador Program is looking for 4-H'ers who are passionate about 4-H and who are able to commit 4-8 hours each month to promote 4-H in Johnson County.

Our Ambassadors meet the 2nd Wednesday of each month for planning or training at the Extension office from 6:30-8:00 PM. Applications are accepted for 4-H'ers from 14-18 years old (before January 1, 2024). Our Ambassadors serve for a one-year commitment and will have the option to re-apply each year following. In addition, first-year Ambassadors are required to attend the Kansas State 4-H Ambassador training typically held in mid-February.

The application process will include the following:

1. Application form/essay completed by 4-H'er due Wednesday, November 1, 2023 by 5:00 PM to the Johnson County Extension office.
2. 4-H Club Leader Recommendation Form to Johnson County Extension office by Wednesday, November 1, 2023 at 5:00 PM.
3. Applicant will receive an email to schedule leader and team interviews to be held Wednesday, November 8, 2023 in the evening.
4. Applicant will be notified of application status no later than November 17, 2023.

All applicants must be present at their scheduled team interview on Wednesday, November 8 (evening times to be scheduled) and be prepared to give their essay/speech they submitted with their Ambassador application.

Kansas 4-H Ambassador Job Description

Purpose:

Work together with a team of Ambassadors, to create public awareness of the Johnson County 4-H Youth Development Program.

Responsibilities:

- Promote 4-H to all audiences; tell the 4-H story through media and personal appearances
- Organize 4-H promotional events and activities
- Develop communication skills
- Promote county 4-H events
- Encourage financial support to 4-H
- Serve on the County 4-H Promotion Committee
- Develop an understanding of Kansas and County 4-H programs
- Support K-State Research and Extension
- Network with non-4-H Groups
- *Attend required training as scheduled (K-State Ambassador training mid-February @ Rock Springs Ranch)

Qualifications:

- High School Freshman to age 18 (*Please note that you can apply for Johnson County 4-H Ambassador Program if you are 14 years of age before January 1, 2024)
- Enthusiasm for 4-H
- Have an interest in promoting the 4-H Program
- Ability to communicate with youth and adults
- Ability to accept and follow through with responsibilities
