Invitational Dog Show Events

Obedience: Provides 4-Hers the opportunity to show their dog's ability to demonstrate specific commands (ie: heel, sit, down, stay, etc.).

- 101-Pre-novice A: Neither dog nor handler have trained or shown before (not State qualifying)
- 102-Pre-novice B: Handler has trained before and dog has not qualified for novice level (not State qualifying)
- 103-Novice: Dogs who have received 2 blue or purple ribbons in Sub-novice level competition
- 104-Graduate Novice: Dogs who have received 2 blue or purple ribbons in Novice level competition
- 105-Open A: Dogs who have received 2 blue or purple ribbons in Graduate Novice level competition
- 106-Open B: Dogs who have received 2 blue or purple ribbons in Open A level competition
- 107-Utility A: Dogs who have received 2 blue or purple ribbons in Open B level competition
- 108-Utility B: Dogs who have received 2 blue or purple ribbons in Utility A level competition

Showmanship: An opportunity to demonstrate how well the dog is shown by the 4-Her.

- 201-Pre-Junior: 4-Her is 7 to 8 years old before January 1, 2023 (not State qualifying)
- 202-Junior: 4-Her is 9 to 11 years old before January 1, 2023
- 203-Intermediate: 4-Her is 12 to 14 years old before of January 1, 2023
- 204-Senior: 4-Her is 15-18 years old before January 1, 2023

Rally-Obedience (Rally-O): There are sequentially numbered signs to indicate the course for the team of handler and dog to heel from sign to sign and perform the exercises at each location. Heeling is critically important for this event, so dogs and handlers should have a minimum of Pre-novice obedience training in order to start.

- 301-RO-Level 1: On lead (not State qualifying)
- 302-RO-Level 2: Off lead; dogs who have received 2 blue or purple ribbons in Rally 1
- 303-RO-Level 3: Off lead; dogs who have received 2 blue or purple ribbons in Rally 2

Agility: By teaching a series of obstacles, the 4-Her provides the basic training and exercise that leads to a more versatile, well-conditioned dog. In order to train in agility, the dog and 4-Her must also be enrolled in Obedience and/or Rally-Obedience training.

- 401-Pre-Agility: On lead (not State qualifying)
- 402-Agility I: Off lead
- 403-Agility II: Dogs who have received at least two qualifying scores of at least 190 points in Agility 1
- 404-Agility III: Dogs who have received at least two qualifying scores of at least 190 points in Agility 2
- 405-Agility IV: Dogs who have received at least two qualifying scores of at least 190 points in Agility 3
